BYLAW NO. 268/15

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF YOUNG TO PROVIDE THE REMOVAL OF SNOW, ICE AND OTHER OBSTRUCTIONS FROM STREETS AND SIDEWALKS

That Council of the Village of Young, in the Province of Saskatchewan in open meeting enacts as follows:

- 1. No person shall place any snow, ice, dirt or other obstruction, swept or cleaned from private property onto any street, sidewalk or lane.
- 2. Council of the Village of Young shall have the authority to request any owner or occupant of property, within the municipality, to remove any vehicles as defined in *The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997* for the purpose of removing snow, ice, or debris on ay street, sidewalk or lane. Owners or occupants will be given twenty-four (24) hours' notice for removal of all vehicles or the said vehicles will be removed by the municipality at the owners'/occupants' expense.
- 3. Any person who contravenes the provisions of this Bylaw is guilty of an offence and on summary conviction shall be liable to pay a penalty of not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), as well as any costs incurred by the municipality to have said snow, ice, dirt or other obstruction removed.
- 4. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of the final passing thereof.
