BYLAW NO. 182/99

A Bylaw to maintain, regulate and control a cemetery.

The Council of the Village of Young in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. The term "municipality" in this bylaw shall mean the Village of Young.
2. It shall be unlawful for the purchaser of a lot or his agent to place markers and plant trees, shrubs and flowers thereon in accordance with the provisions of this bylaw.
3. If any tree or shrub, by means of its roots or branches or otherwise, becomes detrimental to a adjacent lot or lane, the council may direct the removal of such tree or shrub or flowers.
4. The council may direct the removal of any markers, trees, shrubs or flowers placed contrary to this bylaw.
5. It shall be unlawful to place cement tops, fibreglass tops, or crushed rock of any kind on lots.
6. It shall be unlawful for the purchaser to use any type of weed spray or soil sterilent to kill grass growing on lots.
7. The Administrator shall keep an accurate record setting forth the name, the location of burial and the date of burial of the deceased person.
8. The price of lots in the Village of Young Cemetery shall be ~~\$50.00~~ ^{\$250.00} per single lot.
9. The purchaser of a lot shall be given a form with the description of the lot purchased. The forms shall be in Form I, Appendix "A", attached and forming part of this bylaw.
10. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalty of ~~\$250.00~~ ^{\$500.00}.
